The principal alterations introduced into the law affecting highways by the last Highway Act, passed in 1835, are as follows: --The surveyor under the old law was virtually selected by the magistrates; under the new law he is chosen by the inhabitants in vestry assembled, and in places where there is no vestry, at a public meeting of the ratepayers. The time of election is altered from the autumn to the spring, when the other parochial officers are chosen. Statute-labour and all compositions in lieu thereof are abolished; and the expense attending the repair of all highways is to be defrayed by a rate levied in the same manner as the poor rate. Provision is made for the appointment of a board of managers in populous districts, to discharge the duties of surveyors....
